# Admissions to Reception and P1 for 2023!

It is that time again when preparations begin for welcoming new children to our school. We will be holding our Open Day on Monday 19th of December between 10am and 12 noon. If you have a child due to begin Pre-School or P1 in the new academic year we would love to see you. If you are unable to attend the Open Day, contact the office and we arrange can private appointment.

#### **Christmas Show 2022!**

The children and staff of St Eugene's PS are delighted to be presenting 'Aladdin and The First Christmas'. The performances will take place on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> of December in the Farmer's Hall here in the village. There will be a morning show at 10am and an evening show at 7pm. *Please note that all children will go home from the Farmer's Hall after the morning show at approximately 12 noon and will need to return to the Farmer's Hall for 6.30pm in the evening.* 

Tickets for the performances will be on sale from Monday  $5^{th}$  of December and are priced at £4 for adults and £2 for under 16s. Should you wish to purchase tickets please send money in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name, class and how many tickets (adult or under 16) you require written on the front.

We will also have a Christmas Raffle on the night, if you are able to donate any prizes, they would be very much appreciated. Each family will receive a book of 5 tickets by the end of next week. If you require additional tickets after that, they will be available on request from Mrs Gallagher and at both performances on the 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Christmas Dinner**

The Christmas Dinner will take place on Wednesday  $7^{th}$  of December. This will be provided automatically to those on the Free School Meals register. If you pay for your child's meals, please send £2.60 to order the meal by Tuesday  $6^{th}$  of December. Thank you.

#### Covid-19

Covid is still very much present in our community. We remind parents to be vigilant. If your child has symptoms of a cold, high temperature, change of taste and/or smell or a cough you should carry out a LFT. Children who are symptomatic in school will be sent home to be tested. If your child tests positive they must isolate from day zero (the day of symptoms/test) plus three more days afterwards. We need everyone to work together to avoid disruption to whole classes and staffing. You should inform the school if your child is positive.
