UNIFORM FOR NEW ACADEMIC YEAR

A gentle reminder that we will return to formal school uniform for the new term in September. Children should wear full uniform with black shoes. Jumpers should be <u>navy V-neck with</u> <u>school crest</u>, they can be purchased from GMG LOGOS for £ 13.

- Navy V-neck school jumper (GMG LOGOS)
- Navy trousers (boys & girls)
- Navy skirt / pinafore (girls)
- Pale blue shirt/blouse and navy tie
- Black school shoes
- Navy tights or navy socks (girls)

Jewellery is not permitted other than stud earrings. Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back.

PE UNIFORM: PE uniform is the pale blue polo shirt with <u>PLAIN</u> navy bottoms and from September 2024 pupils must wear their school jumper with the crest over their PE uniform, hoodies and other tops will no longer be acceptable.

Uniform grants can be applied for on the EA website. We also offer a range of pre-loved items, which are free of charge for anyone in need. All requests will be handled discreetly.

Folder Bags

All children will need to continue to use their blue folder bags in September. <u>Please note that these can be washed in a cool</u> <u>30-degree wash and air dried.</u> Children new to the school will be supplied with one when homework begins.
