	At 9.15am the teaching staff will bring the children to their classrooms via the main
	entrance as the pupil entrance will be used as works access.
	Miss Gormley will close the gates at 9.15am and anyone arriving after this time
	must report to the office at the main entrance.
School	The cloakroom will be out of bounds during the works for the safety of our children.
Bags and	There is really limited space in our classrooms, because of this, children will not be
Cloakroom.	able to bring school bags or additional items to school for health and safety reasons.
	Children should bring only their homework folder, coat and lunchbox, all
	other items such as hats, scarves, gloves, and school bags must be left at
	home for the duration of the works.
Toilets	All indoor toilets will be out of action. A temporary toilet block has been installed
	outdoors, children will all be asked to use these toilets before class, at break time
	and at lunch time. For safeguarding and child protection children will not be able to
	access the toilets without an adult waiting outside the toilet block.
Home time	Children will be brought to the safe handover point via the main entrance.
	• There may be additional traffic on the grounds, and we ask that parents and
	children take extra care in the car park.

We apologise in advance for the inconvenience that these works will cause, however, we know that it will be worth it for the finished result. We are delighted that the EA are investing in our building to future-proof the school.
